ORDER REOPENING CASE FOR FURTHER PROCEEDINGS

The above-entitled case having been instituted on the twenty-first day of June, 1949, for the purposes stated in the order of investigation instituting the same; hearings having been held pursuant to said order of investigation and the same having been submitted for decision on November 17, 1949, and during said time the legislature having amended Section 2-3/4 of the Public Utilities Act, effective October 1, 1949, creating a class of common carrier known as and designated, "petroleum irregular route carrier"; and certification of said petroleum irregular route carriers having been required by amendment of Section 50-3/4 of the Public Utilities Act, effective October 1, 1949, and said amendment having granted to the Commission jurisdiction over the safety of operations of said petroleum irregular route carriers; and it further appearing that the hearings in the above-captioned case did not specifically consider said petroleum irregular route carriers; and it further appearing that it may be desirable that said petroleum irregular route carriers be made subject to the rules and regulations which may be promulgated pursuant to the above-captioned case, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS ORDERED:

That submission of the above-captioned case be and the same is hereby set aside and said case is hereby reopened for further proceedings to determine whether or not said petroleum irregular route carriers should be made subject to the rules and regulations which may be promulgated in the above-captioned case.

Further hearing in this proceeding is assigned to such commissioner or examiner as may hereafter be designated, and will be held at a time and place hereafter to be set.

The secretary is hereby directed to cause a copy of this order to be served upon all parties of record in the above-captioned case and all petroleum irregular route carriers, and thereafter cause notice of the time and place of hearing herein to be served upon said parties and said petroleum irregular route carriers at least 10 days prior to the date of said hearing.
