ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to relocate its so-called Beale Street lead track at grade across portions of Beale Street, Bryant Street, First Street and Federal Street in San Francisco, (Crossing No. ED-0.75-C, No. ED-0.63-C and ED-0.58-C) as described in the application, and shown on the map attached thereto. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with the readways and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B) at Crossing No. ED-0.75-C, and by one such sign at Crossing No. ED-0.63-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advice the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or

safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
