OPINION AND ORDER

In this application, filed July 21, 1950, G. P. Yordan requested a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a public utility water system in a subdivision known as Mira Loma Park No. 1, located approximately 1 mile north-east of the City of Fresno.

A public hearing was held before Examiner Emerson in Fresno on September 20, 1950, at which time applicant was neither ready nor willing to proceed and had not as yet published the required notices of hearing as directed by the Commission's Secretary. The matter was adjourned to a date to be determined after receipt of notification that applicant was ready to proceed, applicant indicating that said notification would be forthcoming not later than September 26, 1950.

Applicant was advised, by letter of July 27, 1950, that his application did not fully comply with this Commission's procedural rules, the defects being set forth in said letter, and that an amendment to the application should be prepared; this, applicant apparently ignored. By letters of October 25 and 27, 1950, applicant was notified that unless he advised the Commission, prior to November 15, 1950, as to his intention either to proceed or to

request dismissal, the Commission would, of its own accord, dismiss the application. Said date of November 15, 1950, having passed without receipt of any communication from applicant, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that said application be and is hereby dismissed.
