O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to close the crossing of Diana Avenue with its main line and side tracks in the City of Morgan Hill (Crossing No. E-71.0), to remove the crossing and barricade the approaches thereto subject to the following conditions:

1. Previous to the closing of said crossing, Southern Pacific Company shall at its own expense install two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals at the adjacent crossing of Dunne Avenue with said tracks (Crossing No. E-71.1), said installation to provide protection against all movements on each track at said Dunne Avenue crossing. Plans showing the method of operation shall be filed with the Commission previous to installation.
2. The crossing of Dunne Avenue shall be widened to a minimum width of thirty feet in a manner satisfactory to the Commission and the City of Morgan Hill. The cost of such widening shall be apportioned in accordance with an agreement between Southern Pacific Company and the City of Morgan Hill, or failing to agree, will be determined by a further order of the Commission.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order respondents shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
