ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicant is a highway common carrier of used household goods. By this application, filed August 22, 1950, he sought authority to make various increases in his tariff rates and charges. Most of the relief sought was granted by Decision No. 44919 of October 17, 1950, in Case No. 4808, in a general household goods rate proceeding. Applicant has made the authorized adjustments in his tariff. He was repeatedly requested thereafter to amend his application to show the relief now desired. This he has not done. Accordingly, the application will be dismissed for lack of prosecution.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled application be and it is hereby dismissed.
