ORDER

Merced County is authorized to relocate the crossing of Arboleda Drive at grade with a track of Southern Pacific Company, (Crossing No. B-158.5) near Merced in that county, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G.O. No. 75-B).

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Upon completion, Crossing No. B-158.5 in its existing location about 280 feet to the southwest shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
