SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Don D'Onofrio, respondent in the above-entitled proceeding, having conferred with staff members of the Commission's Field Division and having requested in writing the removal of the suspension of his permits to operate as a highway contract carrier and as a radial highway common carrier and alleging (1) that he has restricted the scope of his operations, (2) that he will have outstanding less than ten contracts and (3) that he will perform only occasional operations pursuant to his radial highway common carrier permit; and

Upon recommendation of the Commission's field division and the Commission being of the opinion (1) that the removal of the suspension of the permit to operate as a highway contract carrier is justified and (2) that the request for termination of the suspension of the radial highway common carrier permit should be denied;

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the suspension of Highway Contract Carrier Permit No. 38-6047 heretofore granted to Don D'Onofrio, is terminated, subject to the condition that Don D'Onofrio shall file with the Commission a true and correct copy of each contract under which operations are conducted, together with all modifications and revisions thereof.

(2) That this order shall not be construed, as an adjudication of the lawfulness of Don D'Onofrio's future operations as a

highway contract carrier.

(3) That in all other respects the request of Don D'Onofrio is denied.

This supplemental order shall become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
