## ABERO

The City of Walnut Creek, Contra Costa County, is authorized to construct Alpine Road at grade across a track of Sacramento Northern Railway Company in that city, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 8-26.9. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Sacramento Northern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach shall be substantially as shown on Exhibit "A" attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two reflectorized Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof
