O R D E R

Los Angeles Junction Railway Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across Seville Avenue in the City of Vernon, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 25-1.39-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72 without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. As the industry to be served desires to utilize its track at as early a date as possible, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
