O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Highway Route 7 (U.S. 40) at separated grades over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, near Vacaville, Solano County, substantially as shown by (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. AD-63.2-A, and to construct a temporary detour crossing at grade of said State Route 7 with said tracks as shown on Exhibit "B" attached to the application to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. AD-63.2. Said crossing No. AD-63.2 shall be protected by two Standard No. 5 crossing signals, and upon completion, overhead crossing herein authorized shall be abolished, excepting that the crossing of Mason Street with a spur track now identified as a portion of Crossing No. AD-63.2 may remain and be identified as Crossing No. AD-63.2-C. Said crossing No. AD-63.2-C shall be protected by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said overhead crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time

be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
