O R D E R

Santa Cruz County is authorized to relocate 47th Avenue at grade across a branch line track of Southern Pacific Company near Capitola in that county, to the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. EC-116.7. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, and maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall prepare its ties and road bed and applicant shall bear the remainder of the expense between such lines. Southern Pacific Company shall maintain the crossing between lines two feet outside of the rails. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B), which shall be installed and maintained at the expense of Southern Pacific Company.

Upon completion, the existing crossing of 47th Avenue, about 70 feet easterly, shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty

days after the date hereof,
