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## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

City Carriers' Tariff No. 4 - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 5 provides minimum rates for the transportation of general commodities by city and highway carriers within the Los Angeles drayage area. The tariff is inapplicable on commodities for which rates are provided in other minimum rate tariffs. These exceptions are listed in Item No.40 series of the drayage tariff. At the various times when they were listed, they conformed strictly with the proceeding, decision and tariff numbers and commodity descriptions of the other minimum rate tariffs. Subsequently, new proceedings resulted in amendatory decisions, tariffs were revised or reiscued and commodity descriptions changed. In the interest of clarity and uniformity Item No. 40 will be amended so that up-to-date references will be made to other minimum rate tariffs. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City Carriers' Tariff No. 4 -Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 5 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32504 as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein Ninth Revised Page 13 cancels Eighth Revised Page 13, which page is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

This order shall become effective February 1, 1951.
