O R D E R

The verified application of Pacific Electric Railway Company discloses that the amount of business transacted during the past year at applicant's stations of Wyandotte, Mission Acres and Plummer between Van Nuys and San Fernando Mission, and Hanna, Picover, Reseda and Canoga Park on line between Kester Junction and Canoga Park, no longer warrants their continued maintenance.

The rail lines serving these freight stations were abandoned effective October 22, 1940 under authority granted by the Commission in Decision No. 32599, dated December 5, 1939. At that time the freight stations involved were changed to the status of less than carload freight stations only and applicant has since had in effect with Pacific Motor Trucking Company arrangements to haul for applicant's account less than carload freight between Los Angeles, or points beyond, and these freight stations.

During the past year the business handled at these stations was as follows:

Reseda, the only point at which any business was handled, is located within the pickup and delivery service of Southern Pacific Company freight station of Tarzana, approximately one and one-half miles distant.

Good Cause Appearing, Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to abandon said non-agency stations; to eliminate said names from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
