O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct "Warwick Road Pedestrian Overcrossing" in connection with the construction of Ramona Freeway (State Highway Route 26) over two main line tracks of Pacific Electric Railway Company, in the City of Alhambra, Los Angeles County, at the location shown by the map (Exhibit "A") attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6T-6.00-AD. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with terms of an agreement to be entered into between applicant and the railway company, a copy of which, together with plans of the structure approved by Pacific Electric Railway Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing the work herein authorized. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion such expense by further order.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two (2) years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
