FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, California Water & Telephone Company having applied for authority, by letter dated January 24, 1951, to provide business four-party extended service, which is a new service not heretofore offered or rendered, on a temporary basis for a period of six months in the San Fernando and Monrovia exchanges at a rate of \$6.50 per month for each primary station and having advised this Commission that it will be able to upgrade only a portion of the present four-party business services to two-party service on or before February 11, 1951, as required under Decision No. 45257, and it appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein,

IT IS ORDERED that California Water & Telephone Company is authorized to file in accordance with General Order No. 96, a tariff schedule to provide for the offering of business four-party extended service as may be required for the interim period at a rate of \$6.50 per month per primary station, and after not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, to make such tariff schedule effective on February 11, 1951, for services

furnished on and after February 11, 1951, and to cancel and withdraw said tariff schedule on or before August 11, 1951.

The effective date of this order shall be six (6) days after the date hereof.
