**ORDER**

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that continued maintenance of the Class B non-agency station of Sepulveda is not necessary as shipments destined for this area will in the future be handled through the nearby agency at Glendale. Sepulveda is located in the Los Angeles switching limits and no change in rates or service will result from the elimination of this station or cancellation of tariffs applying thereto. Interested shippers have been interviewed and have no objection.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Sepulveda, County of Los Angeles; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not

exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
