FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant operates as a passenger stage corporation between Fresno, on the one hand, and various surrounding communities including Del Rey, Sanger and Clovis, on the other hand. By Decision No. 45004, dated November 8, 1950, in this proceeding, applicant was authorized to publish for a ninety-day trial period "family commutation rate" books of ten rides for \$3.70 between Fresno and Del Rey or Sanger, and \$2.70 between Fresno and Clovis. The fares published under the authority are scheduled to expire February 17, 1951. Permission to extend the expiration date of these fares for an additional six months is now sought.

The family ride fares are reduced fares established for the purpose of stimulating patronage and revenues. Applicant states that only fair response has developed to this family benefit. However, he believes that the fares should be given a further trial period to interest patronage.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought extension of applicant's authority is justified and should be granted. As the fares expire February 17, 1951, the order will be made effective immediately, and applicant will be authorized to publish extension of the fares on one day's notice.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that D. Moyers, doing business as Moyers Stages, be and he is hereby authorized to extend on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and to the public the expiration date of the reduced "family commutation rate" books as authorized by Decision No. 45004, dated November 8, 1950, in this proceeding, from February 17, 1951, to August 17, 1951.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
