FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 45305, dated January 30, 1951, the Commission authorized Elmer E. Daigh and William H. Stewart, doing business as Daigh & Stewart Truck Co., a copartmership, to sell and transfer to Daigh & Stewart Truck Co., a corporation, properties and operative rights to conduct a highway common carrier business.

The opinion in said decision refers to a certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to said Daigh and Stewart by Decision No. 44263, dated May 26, 1950. It appears, however, that subsequently thereto the Commission entered its opinion on rehearing, Decision No. 44873, dated October 3, 1950, and granted to Elmer E. Daigh and William H. Stewart an in-lieu certificate defining and enlarging their highway common carrier operative rights. Accordingly, it appears that a supplemental order should be entered modifying Decision No. 45305; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 45305, dated
January 30, 1951, be, and it hereby is, modified so as to permit

Elmer E. Daigh and William H. Stewart, doing business as Daigh & Stewart Truck Co., a copartmership, to sell and transfer to Daigh & Stewart Truck Co., a corporation, the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted them by Decision No. 44873, dated October 3, 1950.
