In the Matter of the Application of the County of San Bernardino for permission to widen a crossing at grade over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Railway in the vicinity of Chino, County of San Bernardino, State of California.

ORIGINAL

The County of San Bernardino is authorized to reconstruct and widen the crossing of Riverside Drive at grade with the track of Southern Pacific Company (Crossing No. BAB-518.8) near Chino, San Bernardino County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than 38 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1-A reflectorized crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B). Southern Pacific Company shall bear the construction expense of preparing its track to receive pavoment, including the necessary replacoment of ties, rails, and ballast, together with installation of guard rails, also maintenance cost between lines two feet outside of rails. Applicant shall bear the remaining construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails.

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Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so recuire.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
