SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

V. Fred Jakobsen, doing business as Trans Bay Motor Express Company, the respondent in the above-entitled proceeding, having filed a petition seeking the partial removal of the suspension of his permit to operate as a highway contract carrier so as to permit him to transport property, under contract, between San Francisco and Daly City for two shippers; and

Upon further consideration of the record in this proceeding, the Commission being of the opinion that said petition should be granted; IT IS ORDERED

That the suspension of Highway Contract Carrier Permit No. 1-6300, heretofore granted to V. Fred Jakobsen, doing business as Trans Bay Motor Express Company, be and it is hereby terminated, subject to the condition that operations thereunder shall be confined to the transportation of property between San Francisco and Daly City for two shippers.

This supplemental order shall become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
