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ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to relocate two side tracks at grade across Arden Way in the vicinity of Swanston, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. A-93.5. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B) in addition to the two Standard No. 3 Flashing Light signals protecting the adjacent main line tracks. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Upon completion, the existing side tracks crossing Arden Way shall be removed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the operations of the industry are being delayed pending completion of the tracks and requests that this authority be made effective immediately. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
