In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of an industrial spur track across Pine Street, in the Town of Newhall, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Pine Street in Newhall, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-453.52c. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding five per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alloges that operation of an industry is being delayed pending completion of this spur track and requests that

this order be made effective immediately.
