ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicants hold radial highway common carrier permits. American Stevedore Company also holds a highway common carrier certificate. By the above-entitled application, filed December 29, 1950, they requested authority under Section 11 of the Highway Carriers' Act to charge less than the minimum rates for the transportation of lumber. That section provides for minimum rate relief for contract but not for common carriers. American Stevedore Company was designated by applicants as the party to which correspondence concerning this matter was to be addressed. After its attention was directed to the above-referred to statutory provisions, it requested that the application be dismissed.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled application be and it is hereby dismissed.
