Application of THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, for authority to construct a spur track across Scotts Avenue, in the City of Stockton, County of San Joaquin, State of California. )

ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Scotts Avenue in the City of Stockton, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Scotts Avenue is not improved at the point of crossing, and this authorization shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of said street across the spur track.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant requests that this order become effective on the date hereof as industry is in need of track to move heavy materials; therefore this order shall be effective on the date hereof.
