SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum rates, classifications, rules and regulations for the transportation of property within the City and County of San Francisco are set forth in City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A. The tariff contains class rates governed by the classification ratings of the Western Classification and by the exceptions specified in the tariff. Tariff No. 1-A was established by Decision No. 41363 of March 23, 1948, in this proceeding, and canceled City Carriers' Tariff No. 1. Draymen's Association of San Francisco has called attention to the inadvertent omission in Tariff No. 1-A of a 4th class exception rating on "Paper, Newsprint, in rolls," in carrying forward the exception ratings to the new tariff.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that an appropriate tariff correction should be issued.

Therefore, good cause appearing,
