ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR CITATION FOR CONTEMPT

The City of Covina, on March 5, 1951, having filed with this Commission in the above-entitled case a petition alleging that San Jose Hills Water Company had violated the prohibition contained in Decision No. 44929, issued by this Commission on the 24th day of October, 1950, ordering said San Jose Hills Water Company to cease and desist, until it had secured from this Commission a certificate of public convenience and necessity therefor, from constructing service extensions for the purpose of serving water, or from furnishing water service in the territory in said decision described, and requesting this Commission to cite said company for contempt; and

It appearing from an informal investigation made by the Hydraulic Division of the Commission that said San Jose Hills Water Company, in substance, has not violated said prohibition in such manner as to require the institution by this Commission of a contempt proceeding against said company; and

It further appearing that, by Decision No. 45474 issued by this Commission on the 20th day of March, 1951, a certificate of public

convenience and necessity was granted to said San Jose Hills Water Company authorizing it to construct and maintain a public utility water system in and furnishing water to persons residing in said territory covered by said prohibition contained in said Decision No. 44929, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said petition filed herein by said City of Covina seeking the institution of a contempt proceeding against said San Jose Hills Water Company be and the same is hereby dismissed.

The Secretary is hereby directed to serve a certified copy of this order upon the City of Covina, San Jose Hills Water Company and all other appearances of record herein.

The effective date of this order is twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
