FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 44195, dated May 23, 1950, in Application No. 31316, the Commission, among other things, authorized S. Del George to issue a promissory note in the principal amount of \$22,000 for the purpose of financing the cost of equipment. By Decision No. 44523, dated July 11, 1950, in Application No. 31327, the Commission granted to S. Del George a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the establishment and operation of service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of livestock.

The orders in said decisions required S. Del George to file a report as required by General Order No. 24-A within thirty days after the issue of the note authorized, and to file the appropriate tariffs and time tables as required by General Order No. 80 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A within sixty days after the effective date of the order or orders.

In a supplemental petition filed in these proceedings, S. Del George has advised the Commission that due to absence from the

state he was unable to complete and file with the Commission the several documents called for in the orders in the two decisions. He has requested an extension of time so as to permit him to do so.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that applicant's request should be granted, as herein provided; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the orders in Decision No. 44195, dated May 23, 1950, and Decision No. 44523, dated July 11, 1950, be, and they hereby are, modified so as to permit S. Del George to file with the Commission, on or before June 15, 1951, the reports, tariffs and time tables under General Order No. 24-A, General Order No. 80, and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A, as required by said orders.

This first supplemental order is effective upon the date hercof.
