ORDER

The County of San Bernardino is authorized to reconstruct the crossing of Sierra Avenue at grade with a track of Pacific Electric Railway Company (Crossing No. 6T-49.17) near Fontana, San Bernardino County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than 70 feet, and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Construction expense shall be borne in accordance with terms of an agreement between the parties, a certified copy of which shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost by further order. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
