Decision No. 45563

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of Application of SAN DIEGO AND ARIZONA EASTERN RAILWAY COMPANY, for an order authorizing the construction of an industry spur track crossing County Road along South Line, Sec. 26, T. 18 S. R. 2 W, S.B.B. & M. known as Road Number G-27 in the County of San Diego, State of California.

ORDER

San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across County Road known as Road No. G-27 in the County of San Diego, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 36-12.6.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing sign.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The industry is desirous of an early determination in this matter, therefore the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
