INTERIM ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across Meridian Avenue and a portion of Rancho Avenue in an unincorporated portion of San Bernardino County and across the remainder of Rancho Avenue and Third and Fourth Streets in the City of Colton in that county, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings No. B-537.5, No. B-538.2, No. B-538.4 and No. B-538.5, respectively. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue or street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach substantially as shown on the drawing attached to the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Protection will be determined in a further order in this proceeding.

This authority shall not be construed as authorizing the crossing at grade of said side track with any track owned or operated by any other railroad corporation.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if the above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant verbally advises that an emergency exists, that the crossings are immediately needed for its operation, and requests that the order become effective immediately.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
