FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

The Commission having found that public convenience and necessity require applicant's proposed highway common carrier service between Brawley and Niland, as set forth in the opinion in Decision No. 45538, dated April 3, 1951, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and it hereby is, granted to Pacific Freight Lines, a corporation, authorizing it to establish and operate a service as a highway common carrier, as defined in Section 2-3/4 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of property between Brawley and Niland and intermediate points along and laterally within five miles of State Highway No. 111, as an extension and enlargement of, and to be consolidated with, applicant's present operating rights, subject to the same restrictions and conditions as set forth in paragraphs (1) and (2) of the order in said Decision No. 45538.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
