OPINION

Authority is requested to modify a portion of applicacant's Route 20-B, in the vicinity of Culver City, so as to provide for one-way operation between the intersection of National Boulevard and Venice Boulevard and the intersection of Washington Boulevard and Culver Boulevard, operating over National Boulevard and Washington Boulevard outbound from Los Angeles and over Culver Boulevard and Venice Boulevard inbound to Los Angeles.

No change is proposed in type of equipment, fares or schedules.

As justification for the requested change, applicant alleges that, since the discontinuance of rail passenger service in the center of the divided highway of Venice Boulevard, the City of Los Angeles has been preparing plans for the establishment of one-way traffic on Venice Boulevard westerly from the vicinity of Highland Avenue, which will require the

- (2) That applicant shall give five (5) days' notice to the public of the proposed route change by posting, in its buses operated on Route 20-B, a plainly visible explanatory notice describing said route change.
- (3) That, except as herein authorized, Decision No. 38827, as previously amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of the order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
