OPINION AND ORDER

Applicants seek authority to discontinue public utility warehouse operations in San Diego. They propose that the tariff of Triangle Transfer & Storage Co. on file with the Commission be canceled.

The verified application shows that for the past several years applicants' principal business has been of a non-public utility nature, and that at the present time there are no patrons of their public utility warehouse facilities.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought authority to discontinue service should be granted. Whatever public utility warehouse operative rights in San Diego may be possessed by applicants will be revoked, and the above referred to tariff will be canceled.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the sought authority to discontinue service be and it is hereby granted, that whatever public utility warehouse operative rights in the City of San Diego may be possessed by Ellis Brown and/or P. M. Follensbee be and they are

hereby revoked, and that Local Storage Tariff C.R.C. No. 1 of Triangle Transfer & Storage Co. be and it is hereby canceled.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
