# OPINIC N

By this application, filed December 11, 1950, R. E. and Lucy Wehler (Klamath Glen Subdivision Water Service) seek authority to increase rates and charges for domestic water service rendered in Klamath Glen Subdivision Unit No. One in Del Norte County.

A public hearing in this matter was held before Examiner Emerson in Klamath Glen on April 24, 1951, at which time the matter was submitted for decision.

Applicants' water system is wholly within the Klamath Glen tract, which is primarily a summer resort area of small homes or cabins. Of the 43 water service connections on the system only 18 are year-around or permanent services. Two rate schedules are now in effect. The first is a flat rate, with annual charges payable in advance, of \$16 for a house of three or less rooms and 50 cents for each additional room, and \$1 for each 1,000 square feet of lawn or garden in excess of 1,500 square feet.

Applicants have requested that this rate be increased by \$5 per year for any period of five months during a calendar year. For consumers using the service through the entire year, applicants

request a flat rate of \$2.50 per month and a \$300 yearly charge for Klamath Glen Rescrt. Applicants' second schedule presently in effect is a metered rate with a \$16 minimum charge, which it is requested be increased proportionately. No meters are now, or have been, used on this utility.

Applicants and a Commission staff witness presented testimony regarding the results of the utility's operations together with estimates for the year 1951. Past operations are summarized as follows:

#### a. No records available.

It is of record that applicants have never included any wages or salaries for themselves in the operating expenses of this utility.

The staff estimate of 1951 operations of this system is as follows:

It is apparent that applicants are in need of relief in the form of increased revenues and that the rates requested will produce only a modest return. No person has entered a protest regarding the requested rates or any complaint respecting service. The increases sought will be authorized. Applicants will be required to file a revised set of rules and regulations.

## ORDER

R. E. and Lucy V. Wehler (Klamath Glen Subdivision Water Service) having requested authority to increase rates and charges for water service, a public hearing having been held and the matter having been submitted for decision,

IT IS HEREBY FOUND AS A FACT that the increases in rates and charges authorized herein are justified and that the present rates, in so far as they differ from those hereinafter ordered, are unjust and unreasonable; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicants are authorized to file in quadruplicate with this Commission, in conformity with the requirements of General Order No. 96, the schedule of rates attached hereto as Exhibit A, and, on not less than one day's notice to the public and this Commission, to make said rates effective for all service rendered on and after June 1, 1951.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that applicants shall:

1. File with this Commission, within forty (40) days after the effective date hereof, four sets of rules and regulations governing relations with customers, each set of which shall contain a suitable map or sketch, drawn to an indicated scale upon a sheet 82xll inches in size, delineating thereon in distinctive markings the boundaries of its present area and the location thereof with reference to the immediate surrounding territory; provided, however, that such filing shall not be construed as a final or conclusive determination or establish. Mont of the dedicated area of service or any portion thereof.

2. File with this Commission, within forty (40) days after the effective date hereof, four copies of a comprehensive map, drawn to an indicated scale of approximately 400 feet to the inch, delineating by appropriate markings the various tracts of land, and territory served and the location of the various properties of applicants.
