In Decision No. 45566 in the above titled Application, the Commission by Interim Order authorized Southern Pacific Company to construct a side track at grade across certain streets in and in the vicinity of Colton, San Bernardino County. Said decision provided that protection be determined by a further order. Such protection has now been determined; therefore

Good Cause Appearing it is hereby ordered that the crossings heretofore authorized in Decision No. 45566 be protected as follows:

Crossing No. B-537.5, Meridian Avenue, by 1 additional Standard No. 1 crossing sign.

Crossing No. B-538.2, Rancho Avenue, by 1 additional Standard No. 1 crossing sign.

Crossing No. B-538.4, Third Street, by 2 Standard No. 8 Flashing Light Signals.

Crossing No. B-538.5, Fourth Street, by 1 additional Standard No. 1 crossing sign.

In all other respects Decision No. 45566 is in full force and effect. Since applicant has orally stated that an emergency

exists and the crossings are immediately needed for its operations
the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
