O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one additional spur track at grade across Williams Street in San Leandro, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. L-15.5. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by one additional Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Traffic on Williams Street shall be protected against all train movements over said spur track crossing.

The crossing herein authorized shall be used only for the purpose of providing a track connection to a privately owned industry track as shown on print attached to the application; and it shall not be used as a portion of a lead or ladder track connecting with any other track without further authority from the Commission.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,

necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the operations of the industry to be served will be seriously impaired pending the installation of this track and requests that this authority be made effective immediately.

For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
