O R D E R

The County of Los Angeles is authorized to construct Normandie Avenue at grade across the El Segundo line of Pacific Electric Railway Company near Inglewood, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6RA-11.20. Applicant shall bear the entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 60 feet, and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Banks of earth along the north side of the proposed crossing shall be so cut back as to provide view of the tracks for 150 feet in each direction, from a point 100 feet north of the crossing measured along the center line of the highway.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
