Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a main line track at grade across a county road near Roseville, in Placer County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. A-105.1. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G. O. No. 75-B).

Applicant is also authorized to relocate an existing undergrade crossing of said county road with its tracks (Crossing No. 105.3-B) as shown on the plan attached to the application, said crossing as relocated to be identified as Crossing No. 105.1-CB. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense of both crossings.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

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The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
