OPINION AND ORDER

The above-entitled investigation of the operating rights, operations and practices of Northern California Warehouse Company was instituted by the Commission on May 1, 1951, because it appeared that respondent had a tariff as a public utility warehouseman at San Francisco on file with the Commission, and might not be performing warehouse service thereunder.

Subsequently, respondent's president informed the Commission in writing that the company has not provided public utility warehouse service in San Francisco for many years. He requests cancellation of the company's operating rights and asks for authority to cancel its tariff.

In the circumstances, it appears that the operating rights involved should be revoked and authority to cancel the tariff granted. The proceeding should be discontinued upon cancellation of the tariff. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that whatever operating rights respondent, Northern California Warehouse Company, a corporation, may possess to engage in the public utility warehouse business in the City and County of San Francisco be and they are hereby revoked; and that said respondent be and it is hereby authorized to cancel, not earlier than the effective date of this order and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and public, rates,

rules and regulations in its Warehouse Tariff No. 8, C.R.C. No. 9, insofar as they apply to warehouse operations at San Francisco.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that, upon cancellation of the above-referred to rates, rules and regulations, this investigation be and it is hereby discontinued.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
