ORDER

The verified application of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Bucksport for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof as a station at which freight is handled is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to reclassify its non-agency station of Bucksport, County of Humboldt, from a Class "B" non-agency at which freight in carload lots is received and delivered to a Class "E" non-agency at which freight will not be handled; to change its station records accordingly; and to cancel all freight tariffs and schedules applying at said station on not less than 5 day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after the changes are made as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
