BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the construction at grade of two spur tracks across Walnut Street and Oak Street in the City of Lodi, County of San Joaquin, State of California.) Application No. 32380

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one additional spur track at grade across Walnut Street (Crossing No. D-103.2) and to relocate an existing track at grade across Oak St. (Crossing No. D-103.25) in Lodi, San Joaquin County, at the locations described in the application. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by existing crossing signs and signals. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
