## OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant seeks authority to discontinue public utility warehouse operations confined to the storage of automobiles in Los Angeles and San Francisco. Its verified application shows that no automobiles or other commodities have been stored in applicant's warehouses for a number of years.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought authority to discontinue service should be granted. Applicant's operative rights will be revoked and its tariff on file with the Commission canceled.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the sought authority to discontinue public utility warehouse service be and it is hereby granted; that whatever operative rights applicant, Tenth Street Warehouse Company, a corporation, may possess be and they are hereby revoked; and that its warehouse Tariff No. 3, C.R.C. No. 3 be and it is hereby canceled.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days after the datc hereof.
