ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one additional spur track at grade across Surf Way near Retreat, Monterey County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as portion of Crossing No. E-124.4. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by one additional Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industry to be served by this track crossing requires immediate service and requests that this authority be made effective as of its date. For this reason, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
