## ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Maple Avenue and Annadale Avenue, Calwa, Fresno County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings No. 2V-68.7-C and 2V-68.5-C respectively. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portions of the avenues now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B) at each crossing. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Permit from the County of Fresno shall be filed with the Commission before construction.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
