SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 44952, dated October 30, 1950, as amended, the Commission, among other things, authorized Clear Lake Park Water Company to execute a trust indenture on or before June 30, 1951, and to issue and sell \$20,000 of First Mortgage Convertible, 5% Sinking Fund Bonds, due 1975, on or before October 31, 1951.

Applicant now has reported that it has not proceeded with the authorization granted by the Commission for the reasons, among others, that there is a movement in its service area looking toward the formation of a public district to supply domestic water and other facilities and that, in addition, it is considering modification of the program originally outlined in this proceeding. Accordingly, it has requested the Commission to extend the time within which it may exercise the authorization heretofore granted to it.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that an extension of time to and including March 31, 1952, should be authorized; therefore,



IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which Clear Lake Park Water Company may execute the indenture and issue the

bonds authorized by Decision No. 44952, dated October 30, 1950, as amended, be, and it hereby is, extended to and including March 31, 1952.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Clear Lake Park Water Company shall use the proceeds to be received through the issue of said bonds for the purposes authorized in said Decision No. 44952, dated October 30, 1950, as amended, or for such other purposes as the Commission may authorize in a supplemental order, or orders, in this proceeding.

This second supplemental order will become effective upon the date hereof.
