O P I N I O N

On August 1, 1950, Alberta E. Ferretti, administratrix of the estate of Orrin L. Ferretti deceased, applicant herein, was granted a certificate authorizing the establishment and operation of a service as a petroleum irregular route carrier for the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products in tanks and tank trailers between all points and places in the state of California.

Following the death of her husband she asserts she was unable to continue operating the business and on February 15, 1951, ceased holding herself out to the public as a common carrier of the products enumerated above. Under the circumstances applicant alleges that she finds it impossible to operate the service and requests that the operative right heretofore granted authorizing the service be cancelled and annulled.

Applicant also requests the cancellation of Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 39-4629 and of a highway contract carrier permit, both allegedly formerly held by her. The records of the Commission show that Radial Permit No. 39-4629 was revoked on April 16, 1951, at the request of the applicant, and she never has held a contract carrier permit. It appears that under the

circumstances herein set forth the operative right heretofore granted applicant should be cancelled and revoked and the following order will so direct. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Alberta E. Ferretti be, and she hereby is, authorized to discontinue and abandon operation as a petroleum irregular route carrier between all points and places in California as authorized by Decision No. 44595.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the operative right created by said Decision No. 44595 be and it hereby is revoked and annulled and that all effective tariffs and timetables filed thereunder are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days after the date hereof.
