ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Highway Route 2 at separated grades over the track of the Escondido branch of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, in the City of Oceanside, San Diego County, at the location shown by the map attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2E-0.9-A. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense, and shall file with the Commission, within 90 days, (1) a copy of an agreement entered into between the parties relative to the construction and maintenance of said crossing, and (2) plans of said crossing, approved by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within

two (2) years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
