## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 45350, dated February 13, 1951, the Commission authorized Willig Freight Lines, a corporation engaged in business as a highway common carrier for the transportation of property between San Francisco and Fort Bragg and other points, to execute a mortgage of chattels and four conditional sales contracts providing for deferred payments of \$30,950.94, for the purpose of paying indebtedness incurred in connection with the purchase of equipment and the acquiring of working capital.

The time within which applicant is authorized to execute the mortgage of chattels and the four conditional sales contracts will expire on June 30, 1951. Applicant now advises the Commission that due to the absence of its comptroller from the state and because of the amount of time required to rewrite the obligations, the matter cannot be consummated within the time granted in Decision No. 45350. Accordingly, it has requested an extension of time.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that applicant's request should be granted; therefore,

including September 30, 1951.
