FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 45351, dated February 13, 1951, the Commission authorized E. J. Willig Truck Transportation Co., a corporation engaged in business as a highway common carrier in the transportation of certain commodities between San Francisco and surrounding territory and Los Angeles and surrounding territory, to execute a mortgage of chattels and conditional sales contracts and promissory notes in the principal amount of not exceeding \$245,433.96 for the purpose of paying indebtedness incurred in connection with the purchase of automotive equipment.

The time within which applicant is authorized to execute the mortgage of chattels, conditional sales contracts and promissory notes will expire on June 30, 1951. Applicant now advises the Commission that due to the large number of obligations which of necessity have to be rewritten and the amount of time necessarily consumed in such rewriting and due to the absence of its comptroller from the state that the matter cannot be consummated within the time granted in Decision No. 45351. Accordingly, it has requested an extension of time.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that applicant's request should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which E. J. Willig Truck Transportation Co. may execute the mortgage of chattels and conditional sales contracts and promissory notes authorized by Decision No. 45351, dated February 13, 1951, be, and it hereby is, extended to and including September 30, 1951.

This order is effective upon the date hereof.
