In the Matter of the Application of Southern Pacific Company for authority to (a) abandon its Class "A" non-agency station of Cuneo, in the County of Kings, State of California, and (b) abandon and remove a spur track approximately 1100 feet in length, located at said non-agency station.

O R D E R

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Cuneo for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Cuneo, County of Kings; to remove a spur track at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
